### DB Schenker to offer over 100 direct lanes for ocean freight from South China

(Hong Kong, 15 June 2010) DB Schenker, the leading global integrated logistics service provider, announces the debut of four new weekly consolidation Less-than-Container-Load (LCL) services, reaching a total of 102 direct lanes from the South China region. The new DB SCHENKER *combine* services will include lanes directly from Guangzhou to major cities of Milan, Le Havre, Rotterdam and Felixstowe, developing a more comprehensive regional coverage for the group's LCL product.

“Operated under full control of DB Schenker, the new services aim to offer our customers best-in-class connectivity and price, while increasing cargo safety standards and reducing transit times by eliminating previous transshipments through Hong Kong” commented Henry Schmidl, Director - Ocean Freight, Hong Kong & South China, Schenker International (H.K.) Ltd. “Development in DB SCHENKER *combine* volume has been progressing well over these years and we will further expand our network by adding additional destinations directly from Xiamen and Guangzhou within this year”.

DB Schenker also offers value-added services as an integrated part of DB SCHENKER *combine* and is planning to add temperature controlled equipment to the product portfolio on selected lanes, such as for wine logistics.

Established its Hong Kong office in 1966, DB Schenker has grown to a multi-modal freight forwarding and logistics provider offering land, air, and ocean freight concepts as well as logistics services for Hong Kong and South China. In China, it has over 3,600 employees and operates over 60 locations throughout the country.

### 全球国际货运提供100多条从华南出发的海运直航航线

(香港, 2010年6月15日) 世界上首屈一指的综合物流服务供应商 — 全球国际货运宣布推出四个全新的散货拼箱週班服务, 使华南开出的直航航线增至102条。增设的全球国际货运散货拼箱服务 (DB SCHENKER *combine*) 从广州出发, 直接将货物送达包括荷兰鹿特丹、英国佛列斯多、法国米兰及勒阿弗尔主要城市, 使集团於亚太区提供散货拼箱服务的网络更趋完善。

“崭新的服务由全球国际货运全权操控, 除了旨在提供最佳的运输网络及最相宜的价格外, 同时提升运送货物的安全标准, 更可免除以往货物需经香港中转的情形, 大大节省运送时间。” 全球国际货运有限公司华南地区海运总监 Henry Schmidl 先生表示, “由於近年全球国际货运散货拼箱服务 (DB SCHENKER *combine*) 的货运量增长迅速, 我们将进一步扩大服务网络, 计划於今年内增设由厦门及广州至世界各地的散货拼箱服务。”
