Expansion of Hongqiao airport planned

In order to help develop Shanghai into an aviation hub for China and the Asia-Pacific region, Shanghai's Hongqiao airport will be expanded until 2010. Last year, Hongqiao airport handled more than 19 million passengers, 50% more than the airport is constructed for. The new expansion project will cost around RMB 15.3 billion and will include the construction of a new 3,300 meters long runway and a new 250,00sqm terminal. In 2010, Hongqiao airport is expected to handle 40 million passengers.
