Schenker China MD James Gagne Receives Eminent Magnolia Silver Award

Foreign investors urged to focus on energy saving

Foreign investors are urged to pay more attention to environmental protection and energy conservation. "China will strengthen restrictions on foreign investment in energy intensive high polluting and low efficiency industries," Vice-Minister of Commerce Wei Jianguo told a forum on the social responsibility of foreign invested firms in Beijing yesterday. The country will encourage foreign investment in sectors involved in high-end manufacturing, energy conservation and environmental protection, as well as development and research centers he said. In many

foreign -invested companies, investment into energy saving and environmental protection is better than their competitors. "However, we still see some foreign investors in China simply focusing on cutting costs and neglecting requirements on product security, environmental protection and the security of staff. During this period FDI (Foreign Direct Investment) flow into the manufacturing sector decreased by 4.5 percent year on year to \$17 billion, its proportion down to 56 percent." said Wei.
