Schenker Cargo Charter

First charter to Chengdu transports complete production line



As the No. 2 in worldwide air freight, Schenker provides tailor-made transportation services to its customers - sometimes the perfect solution requires chartering a cargo aircraft for speedy and reliable transport services!

On January 5th, 2008, a B747-400 cargo freighter of Malaysia Airlines (MAS) Cargo landed at Chengdu Shuangliu International Airport after a 4 hours' flight from Kuala Lumpur (KUL). This has been the first chartered cargo aircraft operated by a freight forwarder from overseas to

Chengdu.

The Schenker operated freighter carried a complete production line, which had been moved for a semiconductor manufacturer from Malaysia to Leshan, a city about 200 km from Chengdu. Schenker handled the door to door operations including packing in Malaysia, customs handling, Chengdu terminal operations, loading and unloading, customs clearance, inspection, fumigation and the final delivery to the consignee.

With the strong and com-

mitted work of the Schenker Chengdu team, all of the 70 tons of cargo could be moved to the consignee's factory within 26 hours after the arrival at Chengdu airport.

The general manager of the company assured that he and his colleagues in Leshan had been very impressed with the efficiency and capability Schenker demonstrated throughout the complete operation, mentioning that he would again consider Schenker as a partner for future assignments.
