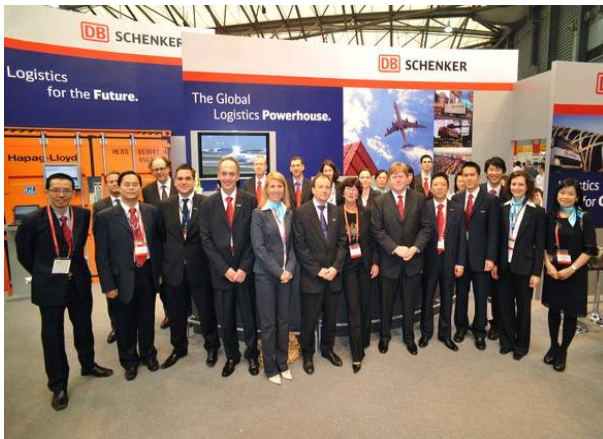

DB Schenker's participation in the transport logistic China 2008

The transport logistic China exhibition for Logistics, Telematic and Transportation has taken place for the third time from 17 to 19 June 2008 in the Shanghai New International Expo Centre (SNIEC). This year's show has attracted 430 exhibitors from 46 countries (+ 43%) and 11,000 trade visitors from 66 countries (+ 22%).

Being a leading provider of integrated transport and logistics services, DB Schenker participated with a 90m² fair stand. Next to showing our general services, our booth also hosted two special areas – an innovation corner where our capabilities in RFID technology as well as the innovative ocean freight product DB SCHENKER*smartbox* were displayed. Besides, there was a section on intermodal, providing information on rail freight solutions, such as the goods delivery from Beijing to Hamburg via rail.

Especially the innovation corner drew a lot of attention, with a number of VIP customers as well as a VIP tour by the exhibition organiser going through our RFID portal to pickup a special DB Schenker gift.

Part of transport logistic China were several conferences, such as the Air Cargo China conference covering the latest developments and trends in air cargo, where Mr. Yuval Perlman, Director, PM Air, China participated in a round table discussion on the topic "The Future of China's Air Cargo Market". Besides, Mr. Fook Keong Wan, Vice President Human Resources, Asia-Pacific held a presentation on the topic "Shortage of employees with special skills: Job Profile for Logisticians in China".

DB Schenker's participation at the transport logistic China 2008 was certainly a great success. During the three days event, the DB Schenker booth attracted over 1,000 visitors, many of them customers and potential customers.

Furthermore, DB Schenker won a prize of "Airfreight Forwarder of the Year 2008" organized by Air Cargo Week on 18th June.

Supporting the Sichuan earthquake disaster relief and rescue effort

The 12 May will always be remembered as a tragic day for the people in China, most of all to those in Sichuan province who endured a severe earthquake measuring 7.8 on the Richter scale. The Sichuan earthquake was one of the deadliest and strongest earthquake to hit China in recent times, with almost 70,000 people confirmed dead, over 370,000 injured, more than 18,000 missing and millions of people homeless. What people desperately need is support to help them rebuild their homes, and most importantly, to help them survive through this hard time.

Being a 'Caring Company', DB Schenker in China immediately initiated a fund raising campaign for all its staff members. In order to support this effort, the company has doubled the final amount and donated the same as all colleagues together. In Hong Kong, our Olympic torchbearer Mr. KP Chan* did not hesitate to put his torch to good use during the local fund-raising event. With a donation of HK\$100 or above, all staff got the chance to hold the Olympic torch and take a photo with it. This incentive definitely helped boosting the donated amount in Hong Kong.

The complete donation of around RMB 1 million has been given to different charity organizations, namely the China and the Hong Kong Red Cross, the Guangzhou Civil

Affairs Bureau and World Vision, which all support the disaster area rescue efforts and to prevent the spreading of the potential epidemics. Managing Directors, Mr. Karl-Heinz Emberger of North & Central China and Mr. Danny Chan of South China, presented two cheques to the Red Cross in Shanghai and Hong Kong on 30 May and 2 June respectively.

Furthermore, Schenker China Ltd. initiated a value in kind donation in which the company and its customers collected toys, children books, children clothes and other commodities for the SOS Children Village in Chengdu, Sichuan Province. These commodities have been delivered to Sichuan by a DB Schenker truck and handed over to SOS Children Village by our Chengdu Branch staff.
