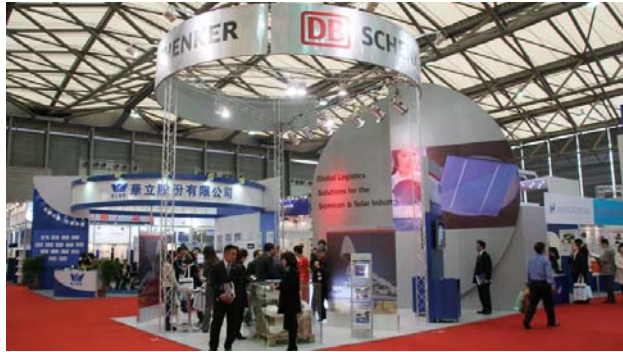
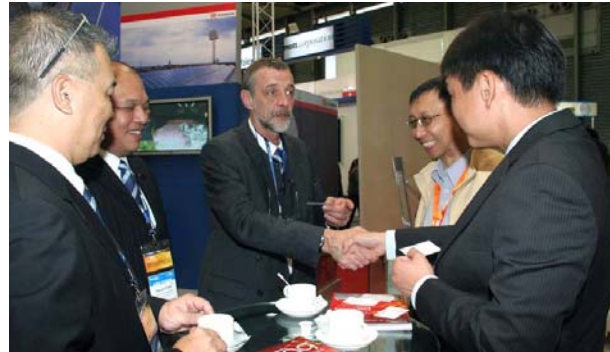


## DB Schenker at the SEMICON & SOLARCON China 2009
